These are End of Course tests that your student will take if they are currently a student in these courses.

The March 7th ACT test will be a day that only Crestview Juniors will report to the high school, and all other high school students in grades 9, 10 & 12 will have online lessons. This will enable a quiet academic environment for our students taking the ACT.
