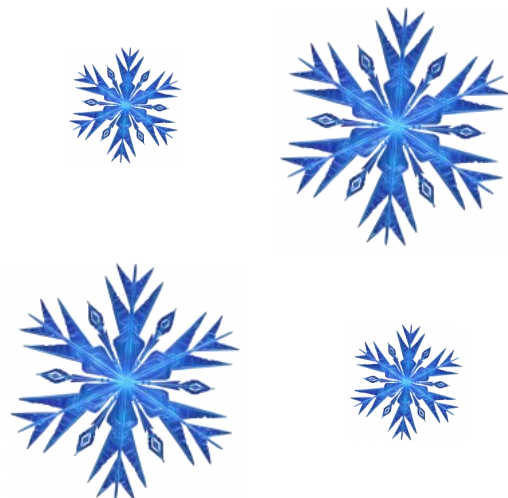

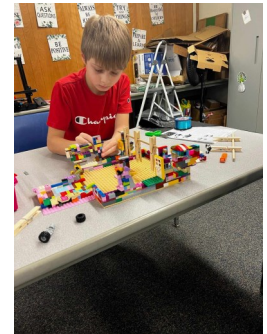
## CLASS OF 2023 PICTURES

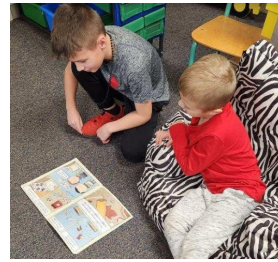


## Art Enrichment!
