We are off to a great start here at Crestview Local Schools for the 2023-24 school year. Students and staff were both excited to get back into the classrooms as we kicked off another year on August 21st.

Lots of changes happened over the summer, between hiring of new staff, rearranging some of our building administrators, and changing the traffic flow for buses, transports and student drivers. All of these changes have gone fairly smoothly and I thank you for your cooperation.

Our fall sports seasons are well underway, all of our student athletes, band members and cheerleaders were hard at work over the summer preparing for their seasons, I invite you to come out and support them! The weekend of September 15th and 16th, all Crestview students will be admitted free to our Varsity sporting events. PARKING PERMITS

Student drivers must purchase a parking permit for the 2023-24 school year. This includes CCCTC students and CCP students who are here for parts of the day, as it is a safety precaution for the students and school district in general. Parking forms are available online on the high school webpage. Students must submit a copy of their driver's license and proof of current valid car insurance along with \$20.00 (checks made payable to Crestview Schools or cash). All student drivers must have a parking permit and participate in random student drug screening, if they have not already done so as a student athlete. Student drivers having a parking permit is part of the Crestview Local School District safety plan.

IMMUNIZATION REQUIREMENTS

Students entering 12th grade in the fall of 2021 are required to have 2 doses of meningococcal (serogroup A, C, W and Y) vaccine. If your child received the first dose of the vaccine after the 16th birthday, a second (2nd) dose is not required.

TRANSPORTED STUDENTS

INTERIM REPORTS

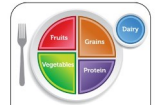

Kindergarten Staggered Start

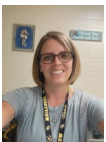
A huge thank you to all our parents as well as our teachers for making these days a huge success! These two days allowed our teachers and staff to administer our KRA and STAR assessments!
