Once a Rebel, always a Rebel,



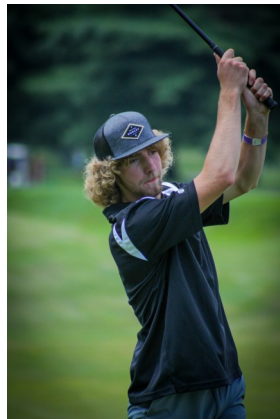

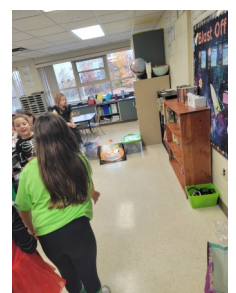
