Curriculum

The curriculum is designed to meet the needs of all students. Honors and Advanced Placement programs exist for academically talented students. The local campus of Genesee Community College also offers courses to students for college credit.

Class Rank

Class rank is determined by the cumulative average and includes all final numerical grades.

Prior to 2015, all Honors, AP, and GCC courses received a weight of 5%. Beginning September 2015, all AP (Advanced Placement) courses are given a 10% weighting factor. All Honors courses receive a weighting factor of 5%.

The Marking System

A 65% is required to pass any subject. Use of the scale below is suggested to convert marks:
