## CCHS Teachers Earn National Board Distinction

CCHS teachers Joy Brush and JK Melton (both pictured to the right) recently received news that they had been officially recognized as Nationally Board Certified Teachers. National Board Certification is a comprehensive process developed by teachers to recognize, reward, inspire and grow accomplished teachers across America, according to their website. To earn this



distinction teachers must pass a rigorous process by submitting a portfolio that looks at 4 components which examine their professional responsibilities.

"We all know that we should reflect on what we do, but my experience is that it is an easy step to skip. It is nice to have some external commitments to give structure to that reflection and to think hard about what I do in class and why I do it, "Dr. Melton stated when asked how this process helped him improve his craft.

"It's a challenging and time-consuming process. I analyzed student work, evaluated videos of my lessons, and completed a science test, " Mrs. Brush reflected.

CCHS math teacher Diane Baca also has earned this distinction and is currently a Nationally Board Certified Teacher. Any teacher that has had their teaching license for at least 3 years can apply.

"You are not alone in the process. I frequently reached out to colleagues and professional networks for support. Their feedback was invaluable in refining my work," Mrs. Brush stated.
