



Math Course

- If you do not see the math course you feel you should be in next year please select the highest course and email Terri Hannigan at terri_hannigan@fuhsd.org
- Please do not take a math course over the summer in between 8th and 9th grade to get ahead. We can not guarantee you will learn the foundation to do well in a higher level course. The summer course will not go on the HHS transcript.
- Geometry is required to apply for the UC/CSU system. Please do not skip.

Electives and Alternative Electives

Types of Electives:

(Must take one year/10 credits in two of the three categories listed below)

- World Language
- Fine Arts
- Applied Academics

<u>Other:</u>

- Other Academic Electives
- Other Non-Departmental Electives



- Electives must be two different classes.
- The alternates must be an additional two different courses so that we are able to give you a full schedule of 6 classes next vear.
- If you do not want to take a different language then you should put an elective from a different area for your alternate.

World Language

Four Languages Offered:

- French
- Spanish
- Japanese
- Chinese
- CSU Requires: 2 Years Minimum (Level 2 = Two Year Requirement)
- UC Requires: 2 Years Minimum, 3 recommended

World Language

- If you have never taken a language before, please Select Level 1.
- If you are a native speaker of French or Spanish, sign up for Level 3 and fill out the Google Form for a placement test.
- The following slides will go into detail on what steps to do when selecting your desired World Language.

French

Students requesting to take **French** have the option to take Level 1 or Level 2, depending on whether or not French was successfully completed in Middle School.

If a student feels that a higher-level of French placement is warranted, please do the following:

- 1. Fill out the Course Request Form using the course name and number for **Level 3** of the language,
- 2. Fill out the google form link on the course request form and take the placement test on **February 28, 2024 at Homestead High School.**

World Language Sign-Up Information

Incoming 9th Grade students requesting to take Chinese, French, Japanese, or Spanish can take Level 1 or Level 2, depending on whether or not a World Language was completed in Middle School. If a student feels that a higher-level World Language placement is warranted, please do the following:

- Fill out the Course Request Form using the course name and number
 - French Level 3; Japanese Level 2; Spanish Level 3 (excepetions SMS Level 2)
 - O HHS World Language-French, Japanese & Spanish Placement
- Fill out the Course Request Form using the course name and number for Chinese 2
 - HHS World Language-Chinese Placement

World Language Placement Information

Spanish

Students requesting to take **Spanish** have the option to take Level 1 or Level 2, depending on whether Spanish was successfully completed in Middle School.

If a student feels that a higher-level of Spanish placement is warranted, please do the following:

- 1. Fill out the Course Request Form using the course name and number
- 2. **a. For CMS students**: if you want to go to a class higher than Level 2, on the course form, fill out level 3, and fill out the google form link
 - **b. For SMS students:** If you want to go to a class higher than Level 1, on the course form, fill out level 2, and fill out the google form link
 - **c. For Non-Feeder school students:** if you want higher than Level 2, on the course form, fill out Level 3, and fill out the google form link

Placement tests will be on : February 28, 2024

SMS students will test at SMS All other students will test at HHS

Japanese and Chinese

Students have the option to take Level 1 or 2. Students requesting to take **Japanese 2 or Chinese 2 (or above)** should do the following:

- 1. Fill out the Course Request Form using the course name and number for **Japanese 2 or Chinese 2. (separate links for both)**
- 2. Fill out the google form link on the course request form and take the placement test on **February 28**, **2024 at Homestead High School**.

World Language Sign-Up Information

Incoming 9th Grade students requesting to take Chinese, French, Japanese, or Spanish can take Level 1 or Level 2, depending on whether or not a World Language was completed in Middle School. If a student feels that a higher-level World Language placement is warranted, please do the following:

- Fill out the Course Request Form using the course name and number
 - French Level 3; Japanese Level 2; Spanish Level 3 (exceptions SMS Level 2)
 - HHS World Language-French, Japanese & Spanish Placement

Other Electives (non-departmental)

Health Education and Introduction to Ethnic Studies (new course to the district 23-24 SY)

- A semester of each course (a full year course = 10 elective credits)
- Must commit to the entire year if selected, 60 students will enroll
- Can take as a 7th class
- A-G eligible

Other Electives (non-departmental)

- Journalism (G elective)
- Yearbook (elective credit towards graduation)

Other Electives (not on the course selection sheet)

- AVID (Application and Interview required)
- Leadership (Elected Class Presidents will be placed in this course in the fall)

Sports and Elective Credit

If you would like to receive Elective Credit for an HHS After School Sport:

- You must remain on the team roster the entire season to get credit.
- Please remember this is elective credit, every freshman must take PE.




Optional 7th Class

Students may request to not have a 6th or 7th period under Optional 7th Request








