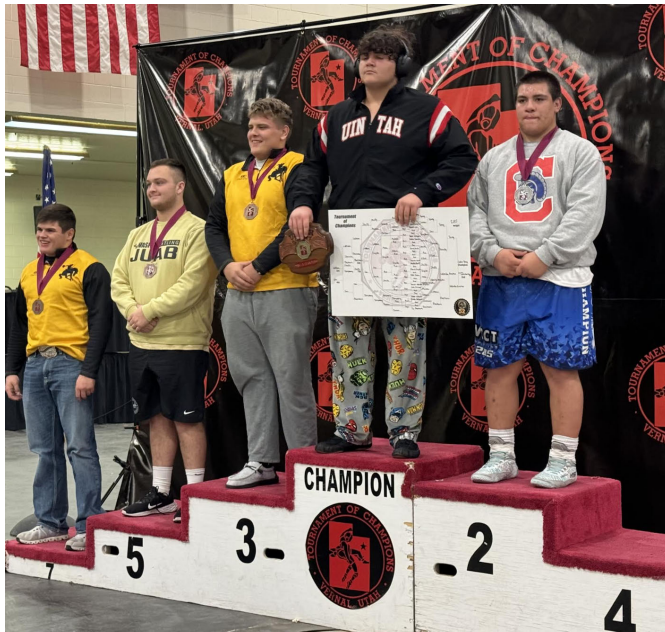


Boys Basketball backed up the girls win on Thursday with an impressive win of their own, defeating Greeley West 77-39 for their second straight 'W'.

#### Seniors Graduation Date:

#### After Prom Hall of Fame Posters:

The Senior Hall of Fame at Centaurus Safe Night After Prom (CSNAP) is a highlight for many Seniors and their families. Parents and guardians of graduating seniors create a collage poster of their child over the years highlighting their life events. Families are encouraged to view the Senior Hall of Fame during the CSNAP Open House, which occurs 8p-9:30p on April 12th at the Lafayette YMCA. The posters are transferred to CHS for display and are then collected by your student for use at family graduation celebrations.

#### Instructions:

To successfully hang hundreds of posters we ask you follow specific Senior Poster guidelines noted [here](#). The DEADLINE for dropping off the posters at the school is April 2nd. Be aware that posters must be laminated in advance of drop off and it typically takes a business a couple of days for the lamination process (the poster is

not laminated while you wait at the counter). We recommended using business sponsor Morrell Printing for lamination or other local print vendors. Lamination allows us to paper punch holes for poster suspension.

#### Poster Building Workshop:

A workshop takes place at CHS March 9th from 10-12 for parents needing inspiration or creative ideas, and others who value financial support for the poster supplies. Be mindful, you need to bring photos of your student to the workshop. We suggest you print a special set of photos for the poster, not using originals.
