



### **FUNDING REQUESTS**

Don reported that the Maintenance Department submitted a funding request for the purchase of a Magnetic 72" Trailblazer Magnetic Sweep for \$1,178.68 and a Duromax Generator and Power Cords for \$3,139.34.
