Enterprise City Schools - Parent & Family Engagement Policy

The Enterprise City School System recognizes the value of parent and family engagement and acknowledges the powerful influences of parents on their child's school success. To this end, the Enterprise City School System supports working toward the development, implementation and regular evaluation of parent and family engagement programs, which will involve parents/families in the decisions and practices for all grade levels in a variety of roles. The parent and family engagement

programs to be developed will be comprehensive and coordinated. Building capacity for the parent and family engagement program is addressed in each schools Continuous Improvement Plan (CIP).
