## 203.2 ORDER OF THE REGULAR GOVERNING BOARD MEETING

### I. PURPOSE

The purpose of this policy is to ensure consistency in the order of business at regular governing board meetings.

#### II. GENERAL STATEMENT OF POLICY

It is the policy of the governing board to consider matters that come before it in a consistent and orderly manner.

#### III. ORDER

- A. The governing board shall conduct an orderly governing board meeting. The governing board will, at all regular governing board meetings, follow an agenda order similar to:
  - 1. Call to order.
  - 2. Approval of agenda.
  - 3. Recognition of visitors.
  - 4. Approval of prior meeting minutes.
  - 5. Consent agenda.
  - 6. Presentation of additional bills for payment.
  - 7. Reports.
  - 8. Written communications.
  - 9. Executive director's announcements.
  - 10. Other old or unfinished business.
  - 11. New business.
  - 12. Adjournment.

# [Note: The governing board should incorporate its preferred order of business into this policy.]

- B. Items in this order may be considered as part of a consent agenda.
- C. The governing board may depart from the order of business with the consent of the majority of members present.
