To the Sierra High Class of 2024 Parents and Guardians:

This letter is to inform you of important Class of 2024 events and deadlines. This will be the first of two parent letters I will be sending out prior to graduation, with the second letter planned for early May. Graduation will be held at Daniel Teicheira Memorial Stadium on Friday, May 24th, at 7:00 pm. Leonard Photography will be offering a package of individual graduation pictures for purchase. Currently, we are planning on handing out 9 tickets per graduate. Everyone (adults, children, and infants in carriers that will take up a seat) must have a ticket to enter. Below are the requirements for graduation that need to be met to receive tickets:

- All graduates must have a blue cap and gown. You may order through our Herff-Jones [representative, Carlos Courtade, by calling 866-238-5336 or emailing cecourtade@herffjones.com or online at www.highschool.herffjones.com.](#)
- To receive your cap and gown at the senior meeting, orders must be placed by January 31st. All orders placed after January 31st will be delivered later. You must purchase by MARCH 1st to receive it in time for graduation.
- All graduates must be cleared on the Senior Clear List. Please feel free to call the school office and inquire about your student's bills, fines, and absences.
- All graduates will be required to complete and sign a "Graduation Agreement" which will be handed out March 20th
- Parents will also be required to sign this agreement and returned to the office by March 28th at 3:00 pm

Important Dates

- March 20 - *Mandatory Meeting for all seniors at 1:00 pm in the large gym (You will receive Graduation Agreement and your cap and gown if ordered by Jan 31st).
- March 28 – Deadline to return Graduation Agreement
- April 13 – Prom 7:00 - 11:00 pm at Brookside Country Club in Stockton – eligibility is required
- April 19 – Deadline to turn in applications for Honor Cords at 4:00 pm
- April 25-26 - E-15 (Every 15 Minutes Dramatization). Seniors will be transported to E-15 sites from SHS
- May 8 – Senior Awards Night 7:00 pm in the cafeteria
- May 10-11 – "Grad Nite" at Disneyland
- May 17 – Deadline for ALL college-bound seniors to request final transcript at www.parchment.com
- May 21 – Baccalaureate 6:00 pm at Sierra High School Cafeteria (nondenominational service)
- May 23 – Senior Sunset- 7:00 pm - seniors meet at the Baseball Field
- May 24 – *Mandatory Senior Class Breakfast/Graduation Practice starting at 8:30 am
- May 24 – Graduation Ceremony 7:00 pm (arrive between 5:45 - 6:15 pm and report to the large gym)
- May 24 - Sober Grad (Location Bowlero – Details to come....contact Nicole Bagley – 6bags@comcast.net)

A Senior Clear List will be posted weekly beginning May 3rd and then daily the last week of school which will inform students of requirements that need to be cleared in order to participate in the graduation ceremony. This will include bills and fines, library fines/textbooks, student laptops, Saturday Schools and all unexcused absences (including single periods), credits, and the graduation agreement. It is your student's responsibility to check the list each time it is posted to make sure they are on track for graduation. Your assistance in getting your senior on track to fulfill his/her expectations is appreciated. Go T'Wolves!

*All graduates must attend the mandatory SHS Senior Meeting on March 20th at 1:00 pm as well as the meeting/breakfast/practice on Friday, May 24, beginning at 8:30am. All dates above pertain to mid-year graduates as well.
