It's Girl Scout Cookie Time!

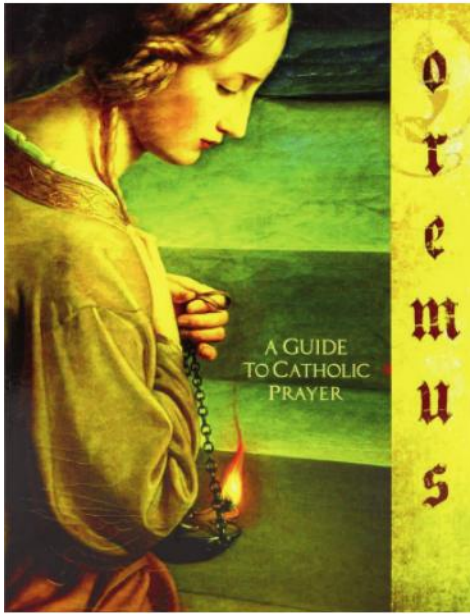

Oblate Mission Appeal January 28

Oblates of St. Francis de Sales serve some of the poorest people in the world as parish priests, ministers, educators, and social workers to provide human and spiritual support for them. The funds raised help provide living supplies, establish food centers, and support work training centers, as well as vehicles to transport children to school and activities. Oblates oversee a hospital and seminary in Ivory Coast in North Africa. They help with the prevention of female students from going into prostitution due to poor living social backgrounds. Saint Francis de Sales Catholic school in Parakou just north of Benin opened three years ago needs financial help for children's programs and activities.

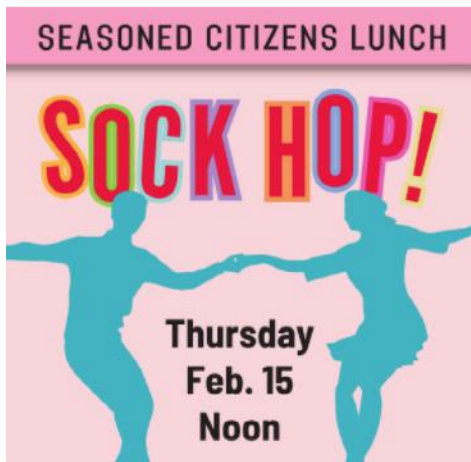

Bonnie O'Leary, Outreach Manager of the Northern Virginia Resource Center for the Deaf and Hard of Hearing and certified peer mentor will be the presenter. She is a late-deafened adult who has been living with hearing loss for more than 25 years. This session will be held on Monday, February 12 from 10 - 11 am at the Vienna Community Center.
