Eastview High School: Class of 2027 Sophomore Registration Worksheet

The school year at Eastview is divided into four nine-week quarters, with seven periods per day. Students have the opportunity to **select up to 28 quarter courses** during the registration process ($4 \text{ quarters} \times 7 \text{ periods per quarter} = 28 \text{ courses}$). Each quarter course earns .75 credit (so successful completion of a year-long course earns $.75 \times 4 = 3 \text{ credits}$ toward graduation). **Tenth grade students must select a minimum of 24 courses**; study halls will be assigned for remaining open periods. Actual placement of courses (including study halls) will be determined during the scheduling process.

Use the worksheet below to guide your selection process. Full-year required core courses (English, Social Studies, Mathematics and Science) are listed first; choose one sequence in each category and select all four quarter courses (A/B/C/D) to meet the full-year requirement. Required PE/Wellness courses are listed next. Elective choices follow, with full-year courses first (World Languages, Choir and Band), and quarter electives at the end. Courses with pre-requisites and other recommendations are identified with an “*”; complete descriptions and additional details can be found online at evhs.district196.org/academics/registration.

If you need help selecting appropriate courses, talk to your current teachers first. Contact elective department/program leaders and teachers for questions on electives. In addition, Counselors will be available in the Commons during p5/lunch throughout the registration window.

Start by marking your selections on the paper registration worksheet. Once registration worksheet is complete, transfer your selections to the online Academic Plan in Infinite Campus (using instructions on the other side of this page).

There are two ways to search for courses:

- ❶ **Course Catalog search** (in the ribbon along the top) will search all courses and bring up full course description, grade level(s), prerequisites, etc. Course can be added right from this screen.
- ❷ You can also search right in the **Academic Plan** in each category. Only courses in that category will show up, with no additional information.

NOTE: You can search by course name or number in both areas.

If you cannot find a course in the Academic Plan, use the catalog search at the top. Some courses are in specific categories and will not show up if you are searching in the wrong area.

If a course is **grey-ed out** in the search list, it is not available to you. This could be due to prerequisite requirements, grade level restrictions, etc. You will not be able to request this course. If your situation calls for an exception to these rules, please see your counselor.

If a course shows up in **red** in your Academic Plan, it is not available to you. While it may be in your list of courses, if it is red, it will NOT be saved and will NOT be included in your course requests. Delete it and choose another course.

Credit totals along the top and in each category are based on a full four-year plan. Credit minimums will not be met until senior year when the academic plan is complete. Alerts are for awareness only. If you are registering for senior year, these alerts will help you determine if you have met the graduation requirements.

Online registration is due by Wednesday, February 14th.
