- **English** – full year required
- **Social Studies** – full year required
- **Math** – full year recommended, may not be required for all students
NOTE: nine full credits (12 courses) and completion through Algebra 2 is required for graduation; a fourth full year is recommended/required by most four-year colleges/universities
NOTE: your current Math teacher likely pre-selected your recommended next course (approval required to make a change).
- **Science** – full year recommended, may not be required for all students
NOTE: nine full credits (12 courses) and completion through either Chemistry or Physics is required for graduation; a fourth full year is recommended/required by many four-year colleges/universities
NOTE: your current Science teacher likely pre-selected your recommended next course (approval required to make a change).
- **Wellness 3** - *NOTE Wellness 3 is required in either gr 11 or gr 12*
- *NOTE: Individual Fitness 10-12 is required and may be taken any time in gr 10-12*

- *NOTE: You must take at least one quarter course in the Arts to meet graduation requirements.*
- *NOTE: You must take at least five quarter courses in Physical Education to meet graduation requirements.*

Eastview High School: Class of 2025 Senior Registration Worksheet

The school year at Eastview is divided into four nine-week quarters, with seven periods per day. Students have the opportunity to **select up to 28 quarter courses** during the registration process ($4 \text{ quarters} \times 7 \text{ periods per quarter} = 28 \text{ courses}$). Each quarter course earns .75 credit (successful completion of a year-long course earns $.75 \times 4 = 3 \text{ credits}$ toward graduation). **Twelfth grade students must select a minimum of 20 courses**; study halls will be assigned for remaining open periods. Actual placement of courses (including study halls) will be determined during the scheduling process.

Use the worksheet below to guide your selection process. Full-year core courses (English, Social Studies, Mathematics and Science) are listed first. Elective choices follow, with full-year courses first, and quarter electives at the end. Courses with prerequisites and other recommendations are identified with an “*”; complete descriptions and additional details can be found online at evhs.district196.org/academics/registration.

Seniors are required to complete four quarters of English courses during their senior year. Choose a combination of two semester courses or a combination of one semester course and two choice quarter courses. See English Department website for more details. *It is recommended to take the full year of Flash and Yearbook; must register for at least two quarters; one must include Q1/A.

Seniors are required to complete four quarters of Social Studies courses during their senior year. Economics is a graduation requirement. Take one semester of Economics plus one semester of Psychology or Sociology, or take one yearlong option (Economics is embedded in all yearlong course options).

It is strongly recommended for students planning to attend a post-secondary education option to register for a fourth year of Math and Science. Placement recommendations were made by current teachers based on your course sequence and progress. For most students, these courses will be pre-loaded into your course plan; see your current teacher with questions or to request a change. Designated students may be recommended to take concepts or foundations level courses; these are permission-only and will be pre-loaded into your course plan.

There are two ways to search for courses:

- ❷ You can also search right in the **Academic Plan** in each category. Only courses in that category will show up, with no additional information.

NOTE: You can search by course name or number in both areas.

If you cannot find a course in the Academic Plan, use the catalog search at the top. Some courses are in specific categories and will not show up if you are searching in the wrong area.

If a course is **grey-ed out** in the search list, it is not available to you. This could be due to prerequisite requirements, grade level restrictions, etc. You will not be able to request this course. If your situation calls for an exception to these rules, please see your counselor.

Alerts are for awareness only. If you are registering for senior year, these alerts will help you determine if you have met the graduation requirements.
