


The mission of Eden Prairie Schools

Physical Education & Health



- All year, every other day
- 3 quarters of PE and 1 quarter of health
- Alternates w/ music (or special services)
- No changing for 6th graders
 - Gym shoes required



Lockers

- Each student is assigned a locker
- Most lockers have a 3-digit combination code
- A key lock accommodation is an option
- Practice, practice!





Hallways & Passing Time

4 minutes between classes

 Students typically have time to stop at their locker or use the restroom between classes

Accommodations can be made, as needed




Student Activities at CMS

Special Education

- Complete online registration by February 16
- Discuss specialized course offerings with current IEP manager at conferences
- CMS sped team will collaborate with elementary IEP managers to ensure that students are scheduled into the right courses



Jan/Feb	Plan for Registration	Elementary IEP managers and CMS staff prepare for registration
February	Register	 Families request courses Elementary IEP managers provide CMS with specialized IEP course needs
March	Plan for Transition	 As needed, CMS IEP managers observe students at elementary sites Ongoing scheduling work
April	Transition Meetings	 Transition meetings (as needed): Please request transition meetings through your 5th grade case manager. Ongoing scheduling work
May	Case Manager Transition Counselors Visit Elementary Sites	 CMS team and elementary IEP managers confirm that course selections aligns with student's IEP and discuss student-specific needs, etc. CMS counselors present to 5th graders at all sites
Summer	Establish Communication	 CMS Welcome letter sent out by Principal Thames Student schedules available mid-to-late August IEP managers will contact families during workshop week
August	Open House	Incoming 6th graders and families invited to Back-to-School events (Contact CMS if special accommodations are needed, early entrance available)


