



# Mustang Pride Behavior Referral Process



# Description of Behaviors

<b>Defiance</b>	<b>MINOR</b> Student engages in brief or low-intensity failure to follow directions and/or expectations	<b>MAJOR</b> Student repeatedly refuses to follow directions and/or expectations
<b>Disrespect</b>	<b>MINOR</b> Student delivers low-intensity, socially rude, or dismissive messages to adults and/or peers	<b>MAJOR</b> Student repeatedly delivers social rude or dismissive messages to adults and/or peers
<b>Disruptive Behavior</b>	<b>MINOR</b> Student engages in low-intensity, but inappropriate disruption	<b>MAJOR</b> Student repeatedly engages in behavior causing an interruption in a class or activity
<b>Language</b>	<b>MINOR</b> Student engages in low-intensity usage of inappropriate language.	<b>MAJOR</b> Student repeatedly delivers messages that include swearing, name calling, or use of words with intent to harm
<b>Technology Misuse</b>	<b>MINOR</b> Student engages in non-serious, but off-task use devices.	<b>MAJOR</b> Student engages in serious misuse of devices. Including material that is sexual, threatening, or intended to harm.
<b>Vandalism</b>	<b>MINOR</b> Student engages in an activity that results in the disfigurement of property.	<b>MAJOR</b> Student participates in an activity that results in destruction and/or disfigurement of property.
<b>Academic Dishonesty</b>	<b>MINOR</b> Student engages in cheating or plagiarism on a formative assessment.	<b>MAJOR</b> Student engages in cheating or plagiarism on a summative assessment.
<b>Bullying</b>	<b>MAJOR</b> Student delivers direct or technology-based messages that involve intimidation, teasing, taunting, threats or name calling. Bullying is aggressive behavior that is intentional and involves an imbalance of power repeated over time.	
<b>Harassment</b>	<b>MAJOR</b> Student delivers disrespectful messages in any format related to gender, ethnicity, sex, race, religion, disability, physical features, or other protected class.	
<b>Fighting</b>	<b>MAJOR</b> Student engages in actions involving contact with intent to harm (eg. Hitting punching, kicking, hitting with an object, hair pulling, scratching, etc.).
