CLINTON SUCCESS CENTER SUMMER SCHOOL 2023

If your child is failing one or more of his/her core academic subjects they will need to participate in our Summer Credit Recovery Session. To be promoted, a student must receive a passing grade of 65 or above. If a student does not pass the core subjects, he or she may repeat that grade. Extended school year credit recovery courses are offered as an opportunity for students in grades 6th-12th to recover credits missed during the regular school year due to failing grades.

The dates of the extended school year credit recovery program are Monday, June 5, 2023, through Friday, June 30, 2023. Students will only be allowed to recover a maximum of two (2) credits during summer school. Credit recovery students must attend classes in person at Clinton Success Center. We will hold orientation from 9:00-10:00 a.m. on Friday, June 2nd, 2023, at CSC. Regular classes begin on Monday, June 5th. **Transportation will not be provided for students taking credit recovery classes.**

Students who failed a class during the 22-23 school year will receive credit for passing the class after enrolling in the extended school year credit recovery program and successfully completing required work. The highest grade a student can receive for credit recovery is a 65, per state law.

Tuition: Students will be required to pay to recover credits during the 2023 Summer School Session. Depending on the number of credits a student needs to recover will determine the amount that needs to be paid. If a student does not pay for credit recovery by June 1st by 3:00 p.m. they WILL NOT be able to begin classes on Monday June 5th. The link to pay for credit recovery is in the registration form where payments are made through MySchoolBucks. The break down of cost per credit is listed below:

½ CREDIT =\$50	1 CREDIT=\$100
1 ½ CREDITS=\$150	2 CREDITS=\$200

If you have specific questions or additional concerns about your child's participation in the extended school year credit recovery program, please contact your child's counselor or principal for that information.

Registration: Students wishing to take a course(s) will need to pay by June 1st by 3:00 p.m. to ensure classes are ready to begin June 5th. Students can apply for summer school credit recovery classes by going to the following the link below or completing the attached application.
