Kyrene School District began developing a strategic plan in 2022, when public education was emerging from the greatest challenges it had ever faced, in a landscape that had been fundamentally transformed. For Kyrene, this presented an opportunity, and as the District engaged thousands of stakeholders in the visioning process, a new picture emerged: of a district that measures its achievement not only on the success of its current preK-8 students but on whether they are ***prepared for success in high school, college, career and life.***

Educating the future of our community and our world is no small feat, and designing a system that ensures each and every student is set up to succeed can feel as big as launching a person into space.

In 1962, President John F. Kennedy was touring NASA when he stopped a janitor to ask what he was doing. DISTRICT GOALS

Our District goals outline the student outcomes we expect to see by 2028. These goals serve to create alignment throughout the organization and to hold us accountable on how to best meet the needs of each of our students.

Early Literacy

85%

Beginning with the kindergarten class in 2024-25, at least 85% of kindergarteners will meet end-of-year DIBELS reading benchmarks, so that by 2027-28, at least 85% of students in grades K-3 are meeting end-of-year benchmarks. *[Kindergarten Baseline in 2022-23 is 74%]*

Academic Progress

70%

By 2027-28, increase the District's Academic Progress percent to at least 70% as measured by the weighted average of students passing, growing, and on-track on state English Language Arts and Math assessments. *[Baseline in 2022-23 is 57%.]*

Sense of Belonging

+10%

By 2027-28, the percent of favorable responses on the sense of belonging items on the end-of-year Panorama survey will increase by at least 10% for students in grades 6-8. *[Baseline in 2022-23 is 39%]*

Equity



By 2027-28, student groups will be more proportionately represented in advanced coursework, gifted identification, discipline referrals and in and out of school suspensions.

Kyrene's strategic planning began around a theory of action.

A theory of action is a concise statement, expressed as a chain of reasoning, that provides the rationale behind the selected strategies. It is a hypothesis of how specific actions will translate to desired outcomes.

every Kyrene student is growing and on track at each grade level to ultimately advance from grade 8 ready to thrive in high school, college, career and life.



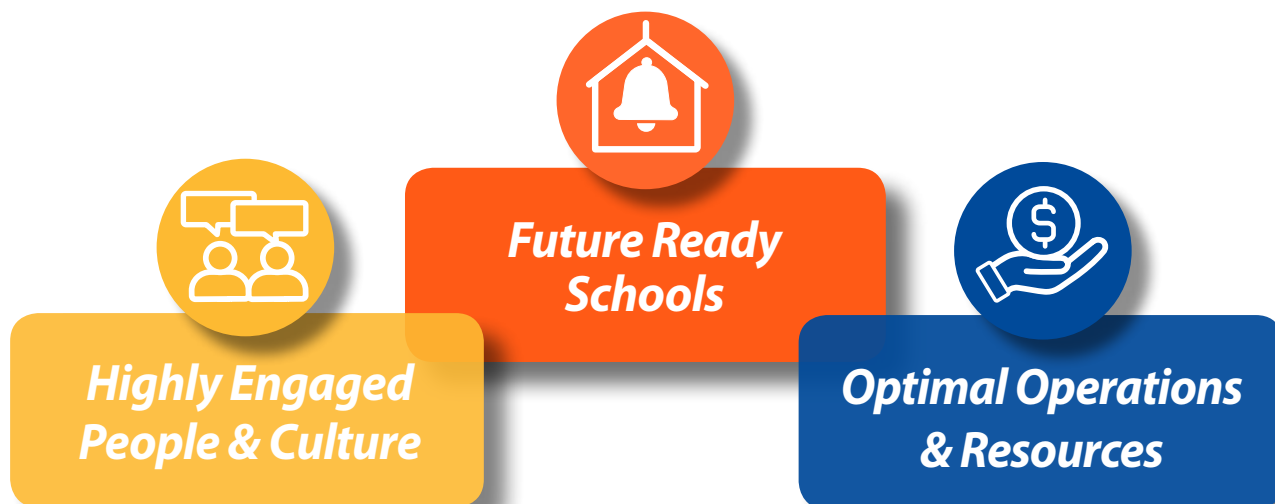

FUTURE READY SCHOOLS

STRATEGIC INITIATIVES

Early Literacy

Prioritize PK-3 literacy and increase access and participation in high-quality early literacy experiences so that every Kyrene student is reading at or above grade level by third grade.

Growth Continuum Model

Apply a growth continuum model focused on actionable student outcome data to expand implementation of the student portrait and accelerate learning.

Social-Emotional Wellness

Increase the integration of developmentally and culturally appropriate social emotional learning with fidelity throughout the school day.

Integrated Educational Technology

Leverage and integrate technology into teaching and learning to accelerate and sustain high impact, engaging and learner-centered instruction across in-person, remote, and hybrid learning modalities.

Whole Learner Focused

Create a culture focused on the whole learner (whole learner means the entire learning system is designed to meet the core needs for safety, critical thinking and cognition skills, literacy and numeracy, physical health and social emotional well-being) that promotes the social, emotional, academic, and cognitive growth for every PK-8 Kyrene learner.

Dynamic Teaching and Learning Environments

Expand dynamic, inclusive teaching and learning environments that empower today's modern learners to co-author their personal learning journeys.

Program Evaluation

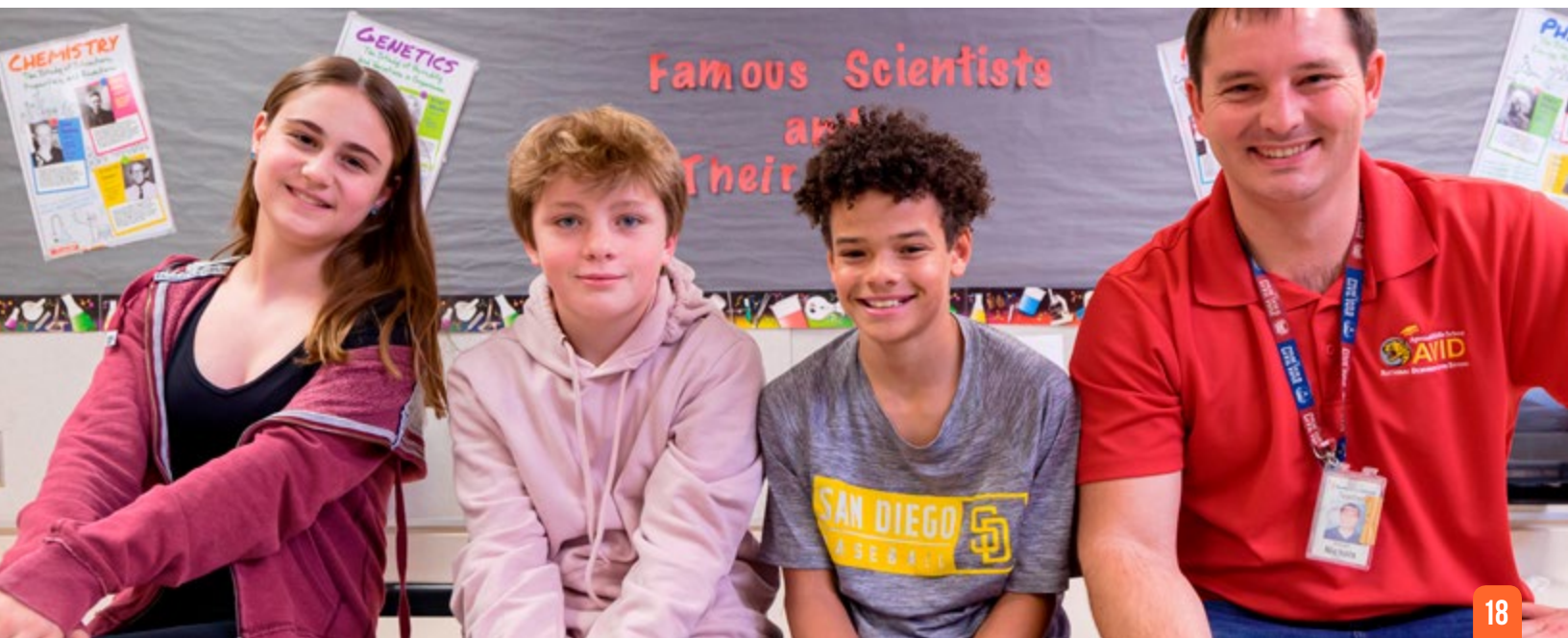
Apply a rigorous system of evaluation to ensure systems and operations are interconnected, efficient and effective, for maximum academic return on investment.
