



Inclement Weather Policy

Conditions

In the interest of User safety as well as minimizing unnecessary damage to District fields, Kyrene School District prohibits the use of District fields during inclement weather conditions. Whenever inclement weather creates unplayable field conditions, affected reservations will be canceled immediately and any applicable fees will be refunded or credited to the User. Fields will be considered unplayable if one or more of the following conditions exist:

- There is standing water on any portion of fields
- There is mud which clings to footwear on any portion of fields
- Any portion of fields becomes measurably indented or depressed when standing, walking, or running
- Ground is easily dislodged or malleable
- Steady rain is falling

User Responsibility and Notification

Kyrene Facility Rentals will update the [Kyrene Facility Rentals - Facility Closures and Updates Facebook page](#) whenever known unplayable conditions exist. These notices and updates will also be posted on the [Kyrene Facility Rentals homepage](#). **It is the User's responsibility to check these pages for field closure notices before a reservation.**

The Kyrene School District covers a large geographical area; as a result, weather conditions can vary significantly from campus to campus. Due to this and the large number of campuses in the District, Kyrene Facility Rentals may not always have access to a timely report of the current condition of every campus, especially in the evenings and on weekends. If there is no field closure notice posted, it is the User's responsibility to refrain from field use and notify Kyrene Facility Rentals if:

- Unplayable field conditions are discovered upon arrival to a reservation
- Unplayable field conditions arise after a reservation is already underway
- The User cancels a reservation on their own accord in anticipation of potential inclement weather

The User should notify Kyrene Facility Rentals of unplayable conditions or cancellations by calling or texting our Rental Assistance line at (480) 848-4588. Please keep in mind that in the event of a User-decided cancellation, applicable equipment and personnel fees may be accrued if notification is not received in a timely manner and will not be refunded or credited.

It is the User's responsibility to notify the User's coaches, staff, and/or participants of any cancellations.

If the User ignores field closure notices or unplayable conditions:

- The User will be held liable and responsible for any accidents or injuries incurred due to unsafe conditions
- The User will be required to pay for any and all repairs and/or maintenance costs as a result of damage to fields
- The User's active and future permits may be suspended or revoked
