## Program Spotlight

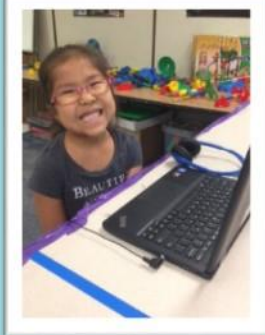
