Sophomore Frequently Asked Questions

FHS COUNSELORS

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Driver's Education:

Q: How/where does Driver's Ed go in my schedule?

A: The system will automatically place you in the correct semester, based on your birthday. Counselors are not able to change the semester you are given Driver's Ed.

Q: Is there Summer Driver's Ed?

A: Yes, Sign-ups in the FHS Main Office after Spring Break.

Q: Are there other options for Driver's Ed?

A: Yes, students can complete the curriculum online through Davis Connect and complete the driving hours at FHS once your online course is completed. Registration for Summer will be in your MyDSD account.

Science

Q: What Science classes are required for graduation?

A: To meet State requirements for science, students need two (2) of the following: Earth Systems, Biology (reg or AP), Chemistry (reg, AP or CE), Physics (reg or AP)

3rd year sciences include any of the core sciences listed above, plus:

Marine Biology, Ornithology, Astronomy, Botany, Biotechnology, Medical Forensics, CE Geology, and CE Medical Anatomy/Physiology.

Fit for Life:

Q: Do I have to take Fit for Life?

A: Yes, Fit for Life is a State requirement for graduation, in addition to 1.0 credits of general P

Q: Can playing a sport @ FHS, Cheer, Drill or Marching Band count for Fit for Life?

A: Yes. If you are planning to be in a Team Conditioning class for a UHSAA sanctioned sport you will have the option to complete the Fit for Life coursework through Canvas and complete the Fit Test requirements to receive .50 Fit for Life credit. Non-sanctioned sports do not have this option. Your coach will have more details for you.

Q: Are there other options for Fit for Life?

A: Yes. A student can opt to take Fit for Life online through Davis Connect.

Digital Studies

Q: What courses are offered at FHS to fulfill the Digital Studies credit?

A: See FHS Course Catalog for course descriptions and best choice for you.

Classes offered at FHS to fulfill Digital Studies requirement:

1. AP Computer Science Principles
2. Business Office Specialist (CE)
3. Computer Programming
4. Exploring Computer Science

Concurrent Enrollment (CE)

Q: What CE classes can I get CE credit for as a Sophomore?
