5. Make sure you are keeping track of your graduation requirements.



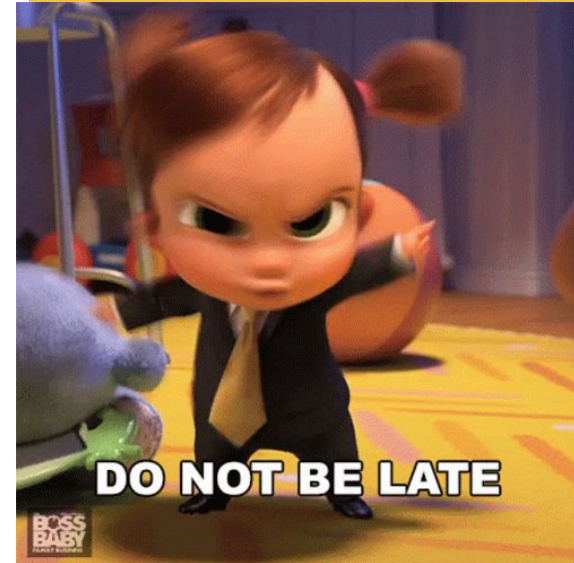

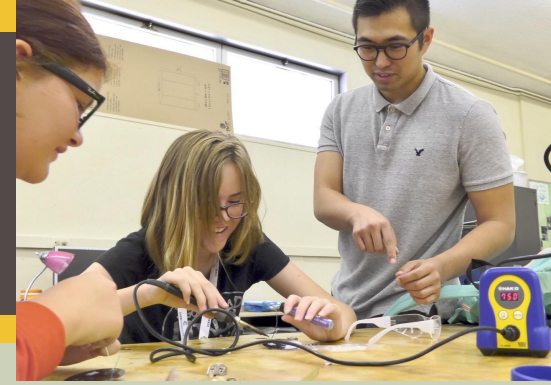
Requirements for 4 year universities/colleges

Course Description:

This hands on class offers a broad range of clay techniques that includes slab and coil construction, pinch pots, glazing, and sculpture. Students will create functional pieces such as a bowl, mug, and vase, as well as decorative pieces. Projects are based on the elements and principles of art. Students will be graded on daily participation, following directions, and written reflections showing knowledge of clay skills and vocabulary.
