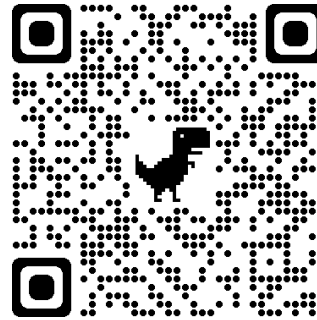

## Student Responsibilities

## Parent/Guardian Responsibilities

## School Responsibilities

Metzgar Elementary School will:

1. Provide high-quality curriculum and instruction in a supportive and effective learning environment that enables the participating children to meet the State's student academic achievement standards as follows:

- Provide ongoing professional development opportunities for teachers
- Provide technology access in each classroom for educational purposes
- Ensure implementation of rigorous academic standards set forth by the Pennsylvania Core State Standards for Math and English Language Arts and Pennsylvania Academic Standards

2. Hold parent-teacher conferences (at least annually in elementary schools) Specifically, those conferences will be held:

- By classroom teachers and specialists at the end of the first nine week grading period

3. Provide parents with frequent reports on their children's progress. Specifically, the school will provide reports as follows:

- Report cards every 9 weeks
- Informational behavior charts on an as needed basis

4. Provide parents reasonable access to staff. Specifically, the staff will be available for consultation with parents as follows:
