Planning Ahead...

Intermediate Requirements:

- All students in Intermediate School must be enrolled in at least one Fine Arts course in grades 6,7, or 8.
- All students in Intermediate school are required to complete a minimum of four semesters or two years of Health and Fitness (Health and Fitness, Pre-Athletics, Athletics, or LDC).
- All 8th grade students must take College and Career Readiness – Professional Communications which is a one-semester course that students receive 0.5 High School Credits for taking. 8th-grade

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The items below are sample three-year plans for students entering Intermediate school for the 2024-2025 school year.

Please remember that students in Intermediate School must be enrolled in at least one Fine Arts course in grades 6,7, or 8 AND are required to complete a minimum of four semesters or two years of Health and Fitness.

Students in Intermediate School must be enrolled in at least one Fine Arts course in grades 6, 7, or 8. Students in Intermediate School are required to complete a minimum of four semesters or two years of Health and Fitness.

Our signatures indicate that I understand that I have selected the courses above, entered them in Skyward Student Access, and will not be allowed to change these courses after April 26, 2024.

Our signatures indicated that I understand that Intermediate School students are required to be enrolled in at least one Fine Arts course in grades 6, 7, or 8 as well as take a minimum of four semesters or two years of Health and Fitness or Pre-Athletics within three years. If my child does not take one of these courses during their 6th grade year, I understand they will be required to take a Fine Arts course in either 7th or 8th and a Health and Fitness course during their 7th AND 8th grade year.

Intermediate Grading

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Grading in CCISD

Elementary

Standards-Based Grading

- Communicates proficiency level on specific state standards
- Multiple topics assessed and reported in each subject area
- Work habits and behaviors listed separately
- Allows learners to set and reach incremental goals

Secondary

Traditional Grading

- Assigns grades including daily work and major grades
- Grades are averaged for each grading period and the semester,
- 100-point grading scale with a passing standard of 70%.

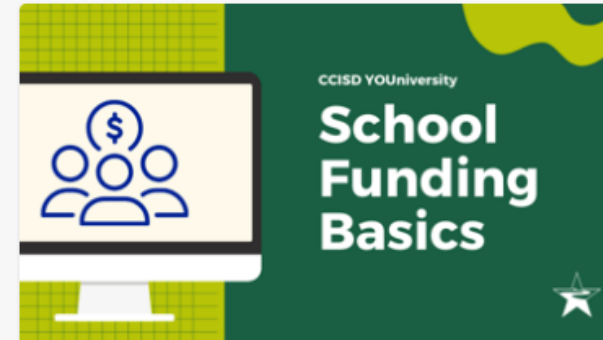
