Classes

Classes for grades K-12 begin in August of 2024. Classes normally have a maximum of 16 students per class in grades K-12

How to Enroll

1. Complete an application for each student you wish to enroll. A \$300 application fee will be charged for each completed application. This fee is non-refundable for students who are accepted but choose not to enroll.
2. Familiarize yourself with Westminster through the website and other recommended resources. Read all required materials prior to your interview.
3. Schedule an interview and testing through the Director of Admissions, Lauren Kelly, lkelly@westminsterknights.org.

Grades K - 2 \$9,609
Grades 3 - 5 \$10,584

Discounts

\$300 OMPC member discount per child
2.5% Sibling discount for each sibling enrolled after the first child

Fees

\$360 Recommitment fee per student (to be invoiced on Friday, January 12, and drafted on Tuesday, January 23, 2024)
\$450 New Student fee per child up to \$1,000 family cap. Alumni families are exempt from New Student fees. *Note – Families who withdraw and then seek re-enrollment will be charged the New Student fee

Tuition Assistance

Tuition assistance applications are filed online using FACTS: [FACTS Financial Aid](#). Applications are due Monday, January 8, 2024. Only families that have recommitted can apply for financial aid.

Tuition Payments

Tuition may be paid in full or in two payments (July and December). Tuition may be paid via autodraft in 11 monthly payments from June 2024 through May 2025. No tuition payment is due during January when recommitment fees are due.
