

Attendance Reminder

Attendance - If your child will not be at school, it is important that you call the **24-hour attendance line at 480 541-4601** to report the absence. Students are marked truant if the office does not hear from a parent/guardian. Parents have 24 hours to report excused absences. Anything after that time frame cannot be changed on your child's attendance.
