The BLHS Registration Guide includes full course descriptions and can be found in the Counseling Office and on the district website. Students must register for classes in Infinite Campus to complete the registration process.

Credits:

- If you need to repeat a core class (English, math, science, social), register for it!

Wright Technical Center:

- This is a blocked course, which means it will use 3 elective spots every trimester. Juniors who are attending WTC will earn 2 credits per trimester. Students should register for the course in Infinite Campus AND sign up on the clipboard in the counseling office.

College in Classroom (CIC):

- These are college classes and you need to meet college admission requirements. Please reach out to your counselor if you have questions regarding your eligibility.

Post Secondary Options Program (PSEO):

- These are college classes and you need to meet college admission requirements.
- Main criteria: Juniors need to be in the top third of their class.
- Students need to attend the BLHS PSEO informational meeting, register for PSEO FS/SS in Infinite Campus, and schedule a meeting with their counselor.
