Guidance Department Updates

Our counselors are excited to continue scheduling for the 2024-2025 school year. Current sophomores are wrapping up the pre-enrollment process for their junior year, and current freshmen and juniors will begin the process in January.

Pre-enrollment and scheduling materials will be presented to freshmen and juniors in SRT on Wednesday, January 17th. Students can input course requests in PowerSchool from January 17th to January 24th. Information about courses offered at Avon High School in

2024-2025 is located in our <u>Program of Studies</u>. Avon offers hundreds of different courses in a large variety of subjects.

Counselors will be meeting individually with each freshman and junior in January and February to discuss classes for next school year, progress toward Graduation Pathways requirements, and plans after high school.

Area 31 Enrollment

Is your current sophomore or junior interested in Area 31? Mark your calendars for the Area 31 Open House on January 25th from 5:30pm-7:00pm at the Career Center at Ben Davis. Area 31 programs are available to junior and seniors at Avon High School and 10 other area schools.

Area 31 students attend career preparation classes for a half-day every day -- either in the morning or afternoon. The other half of the day is spent at Avon High School. Most Area 31 career programs are based at the Career Center at Ben Davis High School. Bus transportation is provided for all Avon students to Area 31 program locations.

Attendance

If your child misses school or is late for any reason, call the Attendance line, (317) 544-5000, option #1. You may call this line 24 hours a day.

Students will be marked 'unverified' (unexcused) without a call from a parent.

If your student was marked unverified in a class for the day, you will receive an automated call that evening. An unverified absence means we have not received a phone call from a parent/guardian about the absence. If you receive this phone call and feel it is in error, please have your student talk with the teacher who marked the absence or you can contact the teacher via email. If the absence needs to be marked differently, the teacher will contact the Attendance Office to make the change.

Early Dismissals

Occasionally, students may need to be dismissed early from school. Please email early dismissal information to AHSStudentServices@avonschools.org. Please include student name, grade, time student is to be dismissed and reason for dismissal. Or, you may call Student Services at 317-544-5000 ext. 5200 and leave a message with all of the aforementioned information. We will deliver the early dismissal pass to the student before dismissal time.



Bus Passes

We will not be providing bus passes for the 2023-2024 school year.



Immunizations

The Indiana State Department of Health sets the immunization requirements for students attending public schools in Indiana. For the 2023-2024 school year, all students in grades K-12 will be required to have 2 appropriately spaced doses of Hepatitis A vaccine and a second dose of Meningitis is required for seniors. Contact your health care provider to ask what vaccines your child may need. Low-cost immunizations are available at the Hendricks County Health Department at (317) 745-9222.
