SCHOOLS FOR APPLIED & INNOVATIVE LEARNING

Each upper school student is required to complete 1.0 credit of SAIL. Students select courses from three schools: School of the Arts, School of STEM, and School of Humanities and Entrepreneurship. Upper school students complete their SAIL courses during two full weeks each academic year. Students may opt to complete their required internship hours during one or both SAIL

INTERNSHIP HOURS

Each sophomore is required to complete 20 internship hours and juniors are required to complete 40 internship hours. These hours are completed at a company/business or organization in a career field that they are interested in pursuing in the future. The hours are logged in Time2Track. Once completed, they will have a Sophomore Seminar and Junior Practicum listed as a course on their transcript with a grading scale of 0-4. This is the same grading scale we use for our SAIL courses. 


CLASS OF 2024 GPA
