Gifted Testing 2023-24 Gifted testing is facilitated at sites three times per year. Information about applications due dates, testing windows, and results are available on <u>www.kyrene.org/gifted.</u> Applications for the first round of testing are due on October 20, 2023. Please communicate the gifted child find message provided below to your communities.

Gifted Child Assessment Notice. All public school districts have an ongoing "Child Find" obligation. This means that the Kyrene School District will identify, locate and evaluate all children within their geographic boundaries who are in need of special education and related services. Kyrene makes gifted testing available for students at school sites three times per year by application. Applications are due for the next round of testing for 2023-24 on October 20, 2023. If you think your child may be gifted, please visit the website at www.kyrene.org/gifted for information about gifted education, services, and testing in Kyrene.



This year there will be a change to the elective selection process for all middle school students. The timeline for the process of selecting elective courses for middle school will be moved to November, which we know is significantly earlier than in previous years. We have moved this process to be earlier in the year to provide our district with the necessary time to assess the staffing requirements for the upcoming school year.

The week of October 23, your child will bring home an elective interest form along with course descriptions for each course. Please review, complete, and sign the paper elective interest form and return to your child's classroom teacher. The week of November 6, children will complete their online elective interest form with the support of school staff. Your assistance with the submission of your child's elective selection form will help us in this crucial planning process.

Incoming 6th graders also need to be placed into core courses (English Language Arts, Math, Science and Social Studies). A letter with recommended course placements will be sent home at the same time as the elective interest form. If you have questions about your child's course placements; please check with your child's 5th grade teacher. Join in the fun for...
