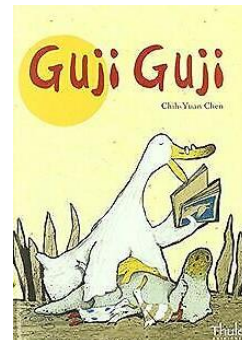


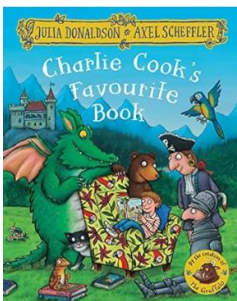
YEAR 1 STAFF'S BOOK RECOMMENDATIONS

Some of Year 1 staff's favourite books to share

- **'Guji Guji' by Chih-Yaun Chen** ~ One day a rather unusual egg rolls into Mother Duck's nest and it hatches to reveal a baby crocodile. The little creature, named Guji-Guji, is brought up and loved equally alongside Mother Duck's other children and becomes a perfectly happy 'crocoduck', swimming and splashing with his duckling brothers and sisters.



- **'The enormous crocodile' by Roald Dahl** ~ The Enormous Crocodile is planning what to have for his lunch. He's the greediest croc in the whole river, and he wants to eat something juicy and delicious. But what can the greedy grumptious brute guzzle up? Beware! He's looking for someone to feast upon... someone who looks a lot like YOU!
- **'Peace at last' by Jill Murphy** ~ The hour is late and Mr Bear is tired. But he just can't sleep - however hard he tries, all he can hear are the noises in the house. SNORE, SNORE goes Mrs Bear. TICK-TOCK, TICK-TOCK goes the clock. Will he ever be able to find peace at last?
