### **CHS Calendar**

**2024-2025 SCHOOL CALENDAR:** Attached to the newsletter is the 2024-2025 school calendar indicating important dates for the school year. Please make note of the dates of student orientation, the first day of classes, and holidays so that you can plan your son's schedule accordingly. We ask that parents not extend vacations or schedule other appointments during school days. Daily attendance at CHS is critical not only to the academic success of your son, but because he can only benefit from the holistic education we offer each day if he is present. **SENIOR SESSIONS:** During the standardized test prep sessions in the second semester, the majority of seniors attend presentations or activities focused

on completing their time at CHS and preparing for the transition to college. See the list below for the content of the Senior Sessions.

- January 24: The legal, mental health, and ethical issues surrounding sexual consent. Guest speakers included representatives from the East Baton Rouge Parish District Attorney's Office, Baton Rouge Police Department, and a psychiatric nurse practitioner from LSU.
- February 1: Transitioning to college, the differences between high school and college, coping with newfound freedom and associated stress, managing the college workload, and other general tips for college. CHS faculty members and mental health professionals will present a variety of ideas to students on these issues.
- February 20: College culture, peer pressure, and other important decisions after high school. An attorney will address the effects of destructive behaviors and potential long-term legal consequences, including alcohol and drug use, as well as the culture within fraternities that can contribute to destructive behaviors. CHS coaches and teachers will reinforce the importance of making good decisions. Additional issues related to the non-academic side of college culture will be explored.
- February 28: Seniors will complete important administrative tasks such as taking a Senior Exit Survey and voting for various awards for classmates.
- March 8: Information on graduation procedures, finish strong comments from administrators, and 2024 Class Picture. Seniors should make every effort to be present for this session so they are part of the class photo. There will be no retakes.

**PSAT PREPARATION CLASSES:** Dates are available for the PSAT/NMSQT Preparation Course for members of the Class of 2025. These six workshops will be offered on: March 9 or 10, April 20 or April 21, May 11 or 12, August 24 or 25, September 21 or 22, and October 5 or 6. There are also make-up workshops being offered in July (July 24, 25, 26). The cost of the PSAT/NMSQT course is \$215. A flier is included in this newsletter with more details about this course, including times.

**SOCIAL MEDIA RISKS:** As most of you are aware, social media poses new and significant risks to young people's well-being. Several teachers and I went to a recent conference on Catholic education, and one of the keynote speakers addressed the effects of social media on this generation of young people, especially mental health. At the conclusion of her presentation, I asked for one piece of advice I could give our parents, and without hesitation she said to make sure students' phones are not in their rooms as they are sleeping. First, students are tempted to be on their phones when they should be sleeping. Second, the studies she has seen also indicate that our brains unconsciously monitor our phones even in sleep, and that affects the quality of sleep. Lesser quality sleep has significant impacts on students' health. The data is unequivocal. She suggested that if the phone is your son's alarm clock, buy him an actual alarm clock.

**ADDITIONAL CAMPUS SECURITY:** Access control has been installed on the front doors of the main building, the doors at the north end of the main building, and on the Br. Gordian Udinsky, S.C. Science Center. All the doors at those entrances will be locked, and students and faculty will use ID cars to gain entrance. Visitors to campus will come to the front doors of the main building where they will be buzzed in by a staff member in the main office.

These newest additions to campus security are important improvements because all building entrances not behind a gate will be locked.

**PARENT SURVEY:** Thanks to the overwhelming response to the Parent Survey that I sent out in the December Principal's Newsletter. The survey is now closed, and I will continue to compile the results and include a summary in the March Principal's Newsletter. Rest assured that your feedback is integral to our planning process as we strive to

make progress in those areas that parents indicate need improvement.

# CHS PSAT/NMSQT PREPARATION PROGRAM

As part of our continuing effort to prepare students to succeed on standardized tests, Catholic High will offer a special preparation program for the Preliminary Scholastic Assessment Test/National Merit Scholarship Qualifying Test (PSAT/NMSQT). It is through this test that students compete for the honor of being recognized as National Merit Semifinalist or a National Merit Commended Student. This test is also the vehicle through which qualified students earn the opportunity to compete for National Merit Scholarships.

Mrs. Christy Kessler will be the workshop presenter. The workshop will include six sessions:
