 - A virtual course
 - First Aid, CPR, AED training
 - Sequential Electives

- To help prepare students for postgraduation, students should participate in one of the following experiences:
 - Earn a credit in an AP, IB, or DE course
 - Earn two or more credits in a stateapproved CTE sequence
 - Complete a WBL experience
 - Complete a service-learning experience
 - Complete three JROTC courses and earn a CTE credential






