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Classroom Procedure Change: Effective Immediately


Due to an increase in traffic in the halls, bathrooms and common areas during classroom time (our Safety Specialist tracked a sampling of 8 minutes with 26 students entering and exiting one set of restrooms), we are instituting a rule effective immediately that has been put in place periodically since our return from COVID in the Fall of 2022. As opposed to living room virtual learning, students continue to need re-learning in a school setting about arriving to class on time and maximizing time in the classroom.

Excluding emergencies, students will not be allowed out of the classroom on a block during the first and last 20 minutes of class time. Similarly, on a Flex Friday schedule, students will not be allowed out during the first and last 10 minutes of class.

We continue to emphasize research-backed findings that confirm a direct correlation between regular classroom attendance and academic achievement. Please speak with your child about timing out restroom breaks, visits to teachers and office staff, and socialization. We want them in the classrooms and actively engaged.
