RMMS Happenings

Pre-K: Preschoolers will spend next week discussing Valentines, love, and gratitude. We'll practice writing skills in our post office and learn about dental health in our science center.

Grade K: In math kindergarteners will be working on mixed addition and subtraction. They will continue working on number decomposition that was started this week.

Grade 1: First graders will begin to explore maps through the postcard project. Thank you for supporting this project by signing up to send in postcards from around the country. They are excited to see if they get postcards from all 50 states.

Grade 2: Second graders will be wrapping up topic 5 in math and starting to learn about regrouping with subtraction. They will also be starting book clubs in reading and working on book reviews in writing.

Grade 3: Third graders will be wrapping up our characters unit in reading and continuing their informative writing practice in writing. In math, we are shifting from area and perimeter to data and graphing practice.



- Fever until fever-free without medication for 24 hours
- Vomiting or Diarrhea until symptom free for 24 hours
- New/ Uncontrolled Cough or Sore Throatcontact MD
- New or Unexplained Rash- contact MD

Obtain a COVID test with any symptoms. To order 4 free COVID rapid tests <u>https://www.covid.gov/tests</u>

<u>COVID-19</u> Common symptoms include Sore throat, Congestion or runny nose, Headache, Cough, Fatigue, Fever, Chills, Muscle or body aches, loss of taste or smell, Nausea or vomiting, Diarrhea. If you have any symptoms, test for COVID right away. What should we do if we test positive for COVID? Isolate and Contact the school nurse.Symptom start date or test positive date is Day Zero, then isolate days 1-5 and wear a well fitting mask days 6-10. <u>Follow the CDC</u> <u>Guidelines for Isolation</u> If someone in the household tests positive, start wearing a well fitting mask for 10 days from exposure.


