With upcoming 24-25 FAFSA changes, Ready, Set, FAFSA sessions will assist students an families with creating a Federal Student Aid (FSA) ID, completing the FAFSA or the MN Dream Act applications and understanding award letters. For 12th grade students and their families; four Tuesday evenings in January.

- All sessions will have simultaneous interpretation in Spanish, Somali, Hmong.
- Students who attend a session or watch one of the recordings will be eligible to win a \$1,000 scholarship!

- These sessions are a collaborative effort between the Minnesota Office of Higher Education, Minnesota Department of Education, ECMC The College Place and Minnesota goes to College.
