Hello everyone,

As we head into the second half of the school year, we wanted to take a moment to remind you about attendance policies at PVE.

- An excuse note is required every time your child misses school. This includes absences on Remote Instructional Days.
- When sending excuse notes, please make sure to include the following information: your child's first name, last name, homeroom teacher's name, date of the absence, reason for the absence, and a legible signature.
- Excuse notes can also be emailed to pvbears.org
- Policies and state law permit up to 10 parent notes per school year. Beyond that, notes from a medical practitioner will be required.

COUNSELORS' CORNER

During the month of February we celebrate Random Acts of Kindness. This year it is from February 11th to the 17th. One of the best ways to teach kindness is to model it. At PVE the guidance department is teaching our students about empathy and compassion. When children learn to understand the feelings of others (empathy) it leads to compassion (doing something to show someone that you care). The act that a child engages in is an act of kindness. Our goal for PVE is that empathy, compassion, and kindness are part of the culture of the school. To create that culture we need to start with a common language. Parents, teachers, family members, older siblings, are all role models for our elementary students. Modeling kind words and actions, even when something is upsetting, can teach valuable lessons. Say good morning to a stranger, demonstrate using manners, use "I" statements when you're mad or sad, and be respectful to others even when others may not be respectful to vou.
