

K-1st Grade Program: \$24,250*
Grades 2-12: \$34,295*

*In addition to tuition, new families are charged a one-time fee of \$1,500 towards facilities improvements.

Tuition

Tuition includes student accident insurance, books, technology and science lab fees, parent association dues, yearbook, and field trips.

Tuition Payment Schedules

A non-refundable deposit of \$1,000 will be processed with your online enrollment; this will be applied towards tuition. Three payment options are available through FACTS for the resulting tuition balance.

Option 1: Pay the tuition and fees in full by 7/5 for a \$20 fee and receive a \$250 discount. Please note that FACTS will charge a \$20 enrollment fee.

Option 2: Pay the tuition and fees in two installments, due July 5, and December 5. As above, FACTS will charge a \$20 enrollment fee.

Option 3: Ten-month Tuition Plan from June 6 through March 6. A \$50 annual enrollment fee will be charged by FACTS (see above).

The additional \$1,500 one-time fee for new families is due with the July payment for options 1 and 2. With option 3, it will be split evenly over the first three of the ten payments.

Tuition paid in two or more installments does not constitute a fractional contract. No reduction or remission of tuition will be allowed by Trident Academy for absence, withdrawal, or dismissal.

Trident Academy Tuition Support Program

Limited tuition support is available for families who meet certain criteria. Applicants must have applied to and been accepted by Trident Academy before grants are awarded. Applications for support and supporting documentation must be submitted to FACTS Grant & Aid (online.factsmgmt.com/aid) as early as possible during the school application process. Students in the K-1st Grade Program are not eligible for Trident’s Tuition Support Program.

South Carolina Education Credits for Exceptional Needs Children Program (ECENC)
