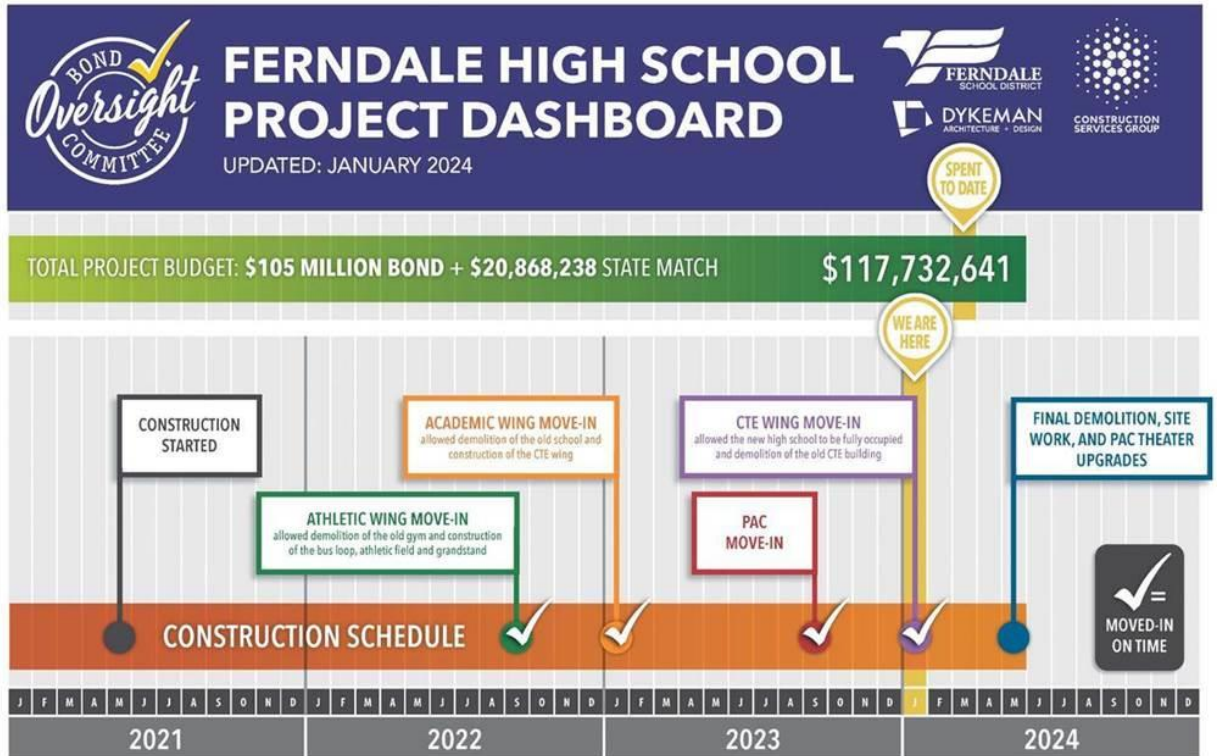

Here are this week's bond-related updates.

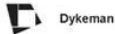
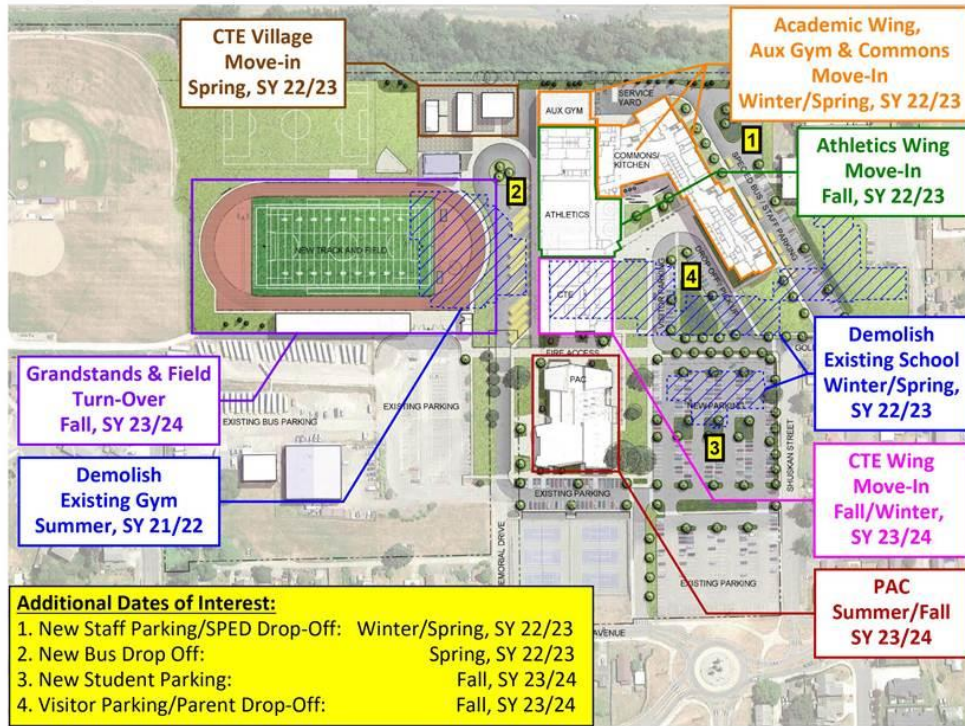

1. Old Main and the old CTE Building were fully demolished this week. Now that this work is finished, the ground will be leveled off and crews will plant grass to stabilize the soil in the area.
2. The final stretch of fencing can now be installed. This will complete the fence line around the campus.
3. Starting in March, a new sound system will be installed in the Performing Arts Center's auditorium, along with several other stage upgrades including new curtains, lighting equipment, and rigging. This work should be wrapped up in May.
4. Ballots have arrived in your mailboxes for the Feb. 13 election! In there, you'll find Proposition 2024-11: Educational Programs and Operations Replacement Levy. Levies and bonds are separate – bonds pay for major construction projects like the new FHS campus, while levies pay for academic and extracurricular programs, school staff, technology, and more.
