





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WHAT ABOUT THE ESSAY?

- The SAT has dropped the Essay from their exam.
- Students can still take the optional essay on the ACT.
- As of 2023 only 3 schools that require the ACT essay for admission & 4 schools that recommend it
- We suggest you take the essay, but don't sweat it!





What About Test Optional Admissions?



If a school you apply to considers test scores a good score can help you

If a school you apply to says it prefers to see test scores you are BETTER taking either test



If a school you apply to is test-optional, you don't have to send a mediocre score

If any school you are applying to requires test scores then you MUST take the SAT or ACT and do well
