



ABOUT RICHFIELD HIGH SCHOOL

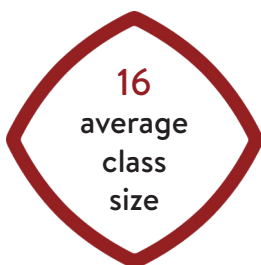
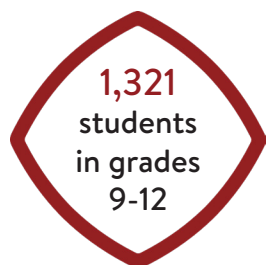
