This scholarship is established with the intent to encourage young artists graduating from Wakulla High School to explore their artistic talent. Many young artists are not financially able to pursue advanced training where their talent and work would develop into a sustainable livelihood.

To help young artists begin their artistic journey, the Wakulla High School Arts' Scholarship will be awarded to up to four seniors pursuing a major or minor in one of the arts: Visual, Musical or Theatre. Seniors must attend WHS full-time and be graduating in the spring of 2023 school year.

Requirements for this Scholarship

1. The applicant must be a full-time senior graduating from Wakulla High School in the spring.
2. The applicant must complete the application form including a typed essay explaining why you are interested in a career (with a Major or Minor) in the Visual Arts. Why is art meaningful to you?
3. Submit 8-10 original works of art in a folder or portfolio. Include both pencil drawings and paintings. Sketchbooks may be submitted and will count for three works. Choose your best works of art, ones that will show a variety of subjects, styles, techniques, etc.
4. Submit 3 Character Reference Sheets from 3 Wakulla High School teachers.
5. Attend the annual Celebration of the Arts countywide performance held at WHS which provides the funding for this scholarship.
6. This application will be due on **March 8, 2024**. Please make sure that it is complete and submitted to Guidance. Portfolios will be taken to the Art Room. Late applications will not be accepted.
