



## FIRST CLASS PRE-K Alabama's Voluntary Pre-K Program Hoover City Schools PRE-REGISTRATION

- First Class Pre-K programs are accepting online pre-registration applications for the 2024-2025 school year beginning January 15<sup>th</sup>. (If you need assistance with accessing the online application, contact the local school/program.)
- Pre-registration is open to all children four years of age on 9/1/24\* who are residents of Alabama. (Children who are eligible to attend kindergarten are not eligible for Pre-K.)
- Registrants must provide a copy of the child's birth certificate. (It may be uploaded into the online pre-registration site or submitted directly to the local First Class Pre-K school/program.)
- Registrants must reside in Hoover and provide proof of residence – either a current utility bill or copy of a lease or mortgage. (It may be uploaded into the online pre-registration site or submitted directly to the local First Class Pre-K school/program.)
- Hoover City Schools Pre-K programs have zoning requirements that determine eligibility for attending a program at a particular school. Zoning is based on Middle School feeder patterns. Berry Middle School may register for Rocky Ridge or Greystone, Simmons Middle School may register for Gwin or Green Valley, and Bumpus Middle School may register for Deer Valley. - There is no registration fee for First Class Pre-K programs, however programs in Hoover do charge a monthly tuition.
- Upon enrollment, a child's immunization record must be provided to the school or program.
- All students MUST be potty trained and be able to take care of all restroom needs independently.
- No child will be denied participation on the basis of income, sex, race, color, national origin, or disability.
