Discovering the Power of Play and Nature with Outdoor Programming

Letting kids be kids is at the heart of Edina Community Ed's outdoor nature program. This hands-off, child-led approach taps into children's innate creativity, imagination and sense of adventure.

Jonah, a 25-year veteran staff member with Kids Club, is one of the pioneering forces behind bringing this program to Kids Club. After completing an intensive training program in New Hampshire, Jonah and a colleague launched its pioneer program at Highlands Elementary in summer 2022. Plans are in place to expand the program to Countryside Elementary.

The nature camp method is all about restoring play, especially unstructured, outdoor play. "It's a catalyst for bringing creative play back and letting kids flourish and thrive by exploring, using their imagination and just being kids," Jonah explained.

Each day revolves around a different theme, often tied to beloved children's stories like "Where the Wild Things Are." Kids are encouraged to dress up,

build forts and structures, and role play along with the theme. Adults supervise but take a hands-off approach, allowing students to take the lead.

This child-directed, sensory-rich outdoor play fosters teamwork, cooperation, conflict resolution and other critical life skills. Unplugged from technology and given the freedom of open-ended play, children engage their senses and exercise creativity.

The pandemic amplified the need for programs like this that get young people outdoors and interacting in a meaningful way. Jonah has seen the profound impact firsthand. "It's one of the more meaningful programs the kids have gotten to experience," he said.

Parent feedback highlights the benefits of outdoor exploration, imagination, and emerging interests that come through the nature-based approach. As demand grows, Edina Community Ed has plans to continue increasing accessibility and expanding more offerings community-wide.

From driver's education to babysitting certification, Edina Community Ed has long provided programs tailored to middle and high school students. Last summer, 141 middle school students attained their babysitter certification and 346 students took driver's ed. However, families may be unaware of the wide range of new courses Community Ed also offers this age group.

“Beyond the traditional classes people expect, we're actively growing advanced, career-oriented, and creative class options where students can explore passions and interests,” explained Edina Community Ed Community Involvement Programs Coordinator, Cheryl Guinness.

Recent course examples span coding, architecture design, Mexican culture and cuisine, unified sports, theater improv, music, and clothing design. The summer 2024 catalog also introduces new nature programs at Valley View Middle School, lunch options for students taking back-to-back Community Ed classes, and career exploration initiatives.

With volunteer and paid job opportunities, Edina Community Ed also prompts students to engage in their community. High schoolers ages 16 and older can obtain certifications to work as lifeguards, swim instructors, and summer Kids Club and enrichment leads. CREATE AT HOME

Strawberries and Cream Popsicles

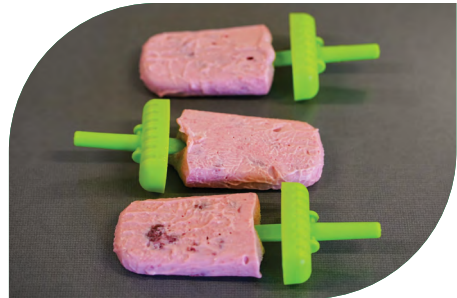
Materials needed:

- 8 oz strawberries (canned, fresh, frozen)
- $\frac{1}{2}$ cup sweetened condensed milk
- $\frac{1}{3}$ cup heavy cream



Instructions

1. In a medium saucepan over low heat, combine strawberries, sweetened condensed milk and heavy cream. Heat, stirring constantly, until ingredients are well combined and just slightly warm.
2. Remove from the heat and pour into popsicle molds, being sure to leave $\frac{1}{2}$ inch of space at the top of the molds.
3. Freeze at least 12 hours.
4. To serve, run molds under hot water to release pops. Serve immediately.





AmeriCorps Fellows Cultivate Connections

In summer 2023, a cohort of AmeriCorps fellows had the opportunity to serve local students through partnerships with Edina Community Ed. Fellows Oliver Leupold, Brian Maginnis, and Nathan Blum recently reflected on their rewarding experiences helping advance Edina Community Ed's work.

The collaboration originated from Community Ed's desire to expand access and impact with enrichment programs. AmeriCorps assigns fellows to communities and helps fill in the community's greatest need and opportunity. Together they're cultivating connections.

Leupold previously worked as a Community Ed summer enrichment lead, so he eagerly applied for the fellowship. Retiree and Edina High School grad Maginnis appreciated the chance to volunteer and give back within his hometown

district. Blum discovered the posting after seeking roles where he could gain teaching experience with youth.

In addition to online training, the AmeriCorps fellows gained hands-on practice thanks to flexible Community Ed programming options. They provided academic support with the elementary scholastic program and assisted various summer camps.

Blum fondly recalled a breakthrough moment helping a nonverbal student beam with pride and literally jump for joy. Maginnis enjoyed bonding with four budding chefs in the cooking camp kitchen and working one on one with elementary students on reading and math skills. Leupold's environmental justice camp overnight allowed him to broaden access to underserved students.



All three fellows emphasized how the experience honed patience and communication skills useful for any career, even if they don't ultimately pursue education roles. They appreciated discovering Community Ed's variety of community programs available.

With enriching results already evident in year one, Community Ed and AmeriCorps are excited to continue this service partnership. "There's an opportunity for anyone interested who wants experience working with youth in a learning environment," said Blum.

By tapping local talent through AmeriCorps fellowships, Edina Community Ed can further its mission to help all students thrive as part of an inclusive and dynamic learning community.

CREATE AT HOME

Summer Beaded Bugs

Materials:

25 inches jewelry wire
(24 GAUGE)

Large bead
(20 MM, FOR BODY)

Medium bead
(10 MM, FOR HEAD)

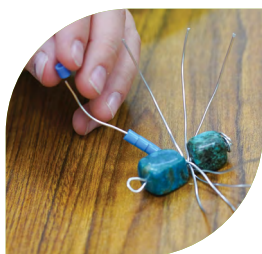
~100 small beads
(2-5 MM, FOR LEGS)

Equipment:

Ruler

Wire Cutters

Needle Nose Pliers



Step 1: Cut wires

- Cut 5 lengths of wire that are each 5 inches long.

Step 2: Attach body bead

- Take one piece of wire and use needle nose pliers to bend the end of it into a tight spiral.
- Continue bending the wire into a tight coil that is large enough to cover the hole in the largest bead (used for the bug's body). Think that the coil is about 5 mm in size.
- Now take the other end of the wire and feed it through the center of the coil.
- Pull the end of the wire completely through. This secures the coil and ensures that the hole of the large bead will sit in the center of the coil.
- Now slide the largest bead (the body) onto the wire until it's resting against the coil.

Step 3: Connect legs

- Grab one of the other four wires and bend it roughly in half in a "U" shape to find the middle.
- Slide the folded wire around the first wire, so it's sitting against the body bead.
- Cross the folded wire around itself.
- Pull the wire down on each side, securing it into place.
- You've just added the first two bug legs!
- Repeat these steps with the next three wires and pinch the legs in place with your pliers.
- Don't worry about the legs intertwining—it only makes the bug more sturdy.

Step 4: Attach and secure head bead

- You can now slide the medium sized head bead onto the center wire and press it tightly against the legs.
- Cut off any excess wire, leaving at least 2 cm (or 3/4 inch).
- Use the pliers to twist and push the end of the wire back into the head bead, creating a small loop to secure it.

Step 5: Bead legs

- Bend and separate the 8 legs into their positions.
- Begin beading the first leg. It's best to start with a small seed bead so it will rest right up against the bug's body.
- Use a mix of beads in a variety of sizes. We used 12 beads per leg, but the number will depend on the exact size of your beads.
- Make sure to leave 5-10 mm at the end of the wire to finish off the leg. Use the needle nose pliers to create a small loop, just large enough to ensure the beads won't slide off.
- Bead the other 7 legs, and your bug is almost ready!

Step 6: Arrange legs

- Bend each of the 8 legs, somewhere around the middle of the leg, to create the leg joint.
- Flip the bug over and adjust the legs so they all touch the table and are evenly spaced out.

Your beaded bug is complete!

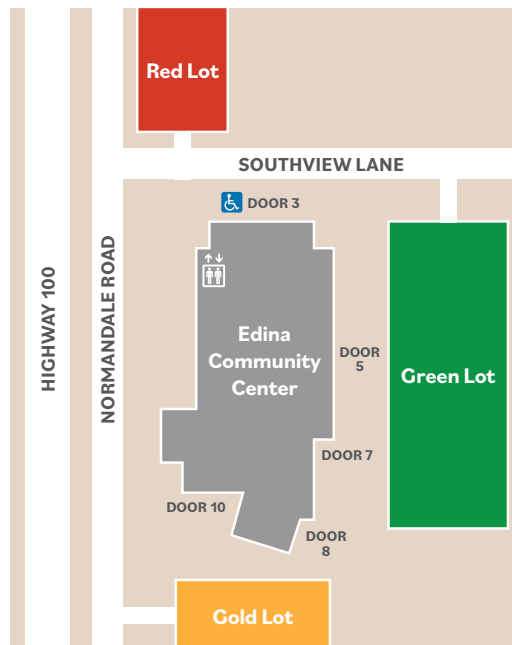
