ATTENDANCE

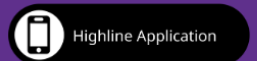

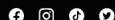

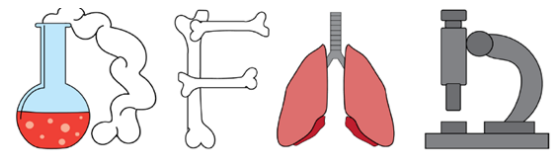
