ACT Prep and Test for Juniors

On Tuesday, February 27, 2024, all juniors will take the ACT test at Louisville High School. Success on the ACT can provide access to scholarship opportunities as well as give you great information on your areas of strength and growth for college and your career. It is an alternative to demonstrating competency in English and Math. Remediation free in all areas earns the College Ready Seal for graduation and a score of 27 can help a student towards an Honors Diploma!

We are offering two **FREE opportunities** for you to prepare. Studies show that students often raise their scores by taking full-length tests prior to the real test. We will offer full-length practice tests. Our first test is on Thursday, February 8, 2024 from 2:30-6:00 p.m. (This sign-up window has closed.)
