AUCTION FAQs

When and where is the auction?

Saturday, February 10, 2024, in the Evergreen Ballroom at the Hyatt Regency Hotel in Bellevue.

Are we required to attend the auction?

Attendance at the auction is not mandatory, but you will miss out on some amazing deals, great food, and a fun time!

What time should we arrive?

For individuals who purchased Show Your Heart tickets and for School Sponsors, doors open at 5 p.m. All ticket holders may enter at 5:30 p.m.

Pre-ballroom time is filled with many fun activities, including the Almost Live silent auction, teacher experiences, raffle sales, and a close-up look at the classroom project photo books offered in the Online Silent auction. It is also a chance to share a drink and catch up with your Sacred Heart friends, both new and old.

What is Fund-A-Need and how can I participate?

Every year, Sacred Heart School identifies an area, or areas, of need. In years past, some of these have included a new Big Toy, remodeling projects, a new industrial kitchen, and purchasing needed items and improvements for the school. AUCTION FAQs

Do I need to attend the auction to bid on Fund-A-Need?

No, there will be a link provided where anyone can make a donation outside of the auction if you so choose. Share the link with anyone who wants to join in supporting our Fund-A-Need!

How does the Almost Live silent auction work?

Items for bidding will be displayed on tables throughout the lobby adjacent to the ballroom. Each item will have a bid sheet listing the approximate retail value of the item, the minimum starting bid, and the acceptable bidding increments. If you wish to bid on an item, write your bid number beside the amount of your bid. The subsequent bidder must offer a higher amount equal to, or greater than, the posted acceptable bid increment. If your heart is set on winning an item, be sure to check back before the bidding closes to place the final, or guaranteed, bid! When the bidding closes, the person having placed the highest bid will win the item for the amount stated. Bidding closes at 7 p.m sharp.

What is The Rock Paper Scissors Showdown?

Join us at the start of the Live Auction to play a fun game of chance! For only \$25 per player, you could win an amazing \$500 gift card to any store of your choice! There will be one sheet per table to sign up. When you arrive at your table, write your bid number down for each person playing. Volunteers will visit your table to collect these sheets shortly before the Live Auction begins. The auctioneer will call each round of Rock, Paper, Scissors. Last person standing is the winner! What is a Teacher Experience?

Our teachers have many gifts to offer, and they also have many interesting specialties! The generous staff will be sharing their time and talents with our children to create Sacred Heart School memories. There will be a specified table during the pre-ballroom time where you can bid on these amazing, one-of-a-kind experiences!

How do I get the items that I win?

Highest bidders will be charged for the items purchased. All items purchased, including items from the Online Silent, will be available to pick up at Sacred Heart School the following week. Sarah Hanley will contact you the week after the Auction for you to collect your items.

I have tickets to the Après Party. What are the details for this?

The Après Party* is such a fun way to end the auction! This year, our Après Party event will take place in the room adjacent to the ballroom. There will be a dance floor, DJ, and late-night snacks. The Après Party will kick off immediately after the auction and will end around midnight.

*The Après Party is only for those individuals who purchased tickets to attend the event. The event bracelets will be in your registration packets. Please wear them to gain entry into the Après Party at the door. You may also purchase tickets during the check-in process.

What are our options if we do not have a designated driver in our party?

We want everyone to have a safe ride home from the auction, so be sure to download the Uber or Lyft app before the event.

AUCTION RULES

Check-In and Check-Out

For express check out, please provide a Visa, MasterCard, or American Express card at the registration desk. Credit cards will be recorded with an electronic swipe. If no charges are incurred, your method of payment will not be charged.

Tax Deduction

Auction purchases may not be tax deductible as provided by law. Please consult a tax advisor regarding tax laws and the deductibility of certain purchases and fair market value. Fund-A-Need is fully tax deductible.

Payment

All sales are final. No refunds or exchanges are permitted. Payment must be in the form of a check, Visa, MasterCard, or American Express card. If you wish to pay by stock transfer post-auction, please contact Sarah Hanley no later than Monday, February 12, following the event to request the form to start the transfer process. For items that are jointly purchased by two or more parties, we have the ability to split bids among multiple bidders and split the item value among those same bidders.
