2024-25 COURSE REGISTRATION INFORMATION

All grade levels will enter course requests in Skyward *Student Access* during February 19 – March 8. Use the SCHEDULE tab and follow the instructions in the Skyward handout.

Students who have not selected courses by March 8 will have courses selected for them.

Don't forget to request alternates, as mentioned in the directions, so an optimal and full schedule can be created. If you do not request alternates, we will select the "back-up" courses for you.

Review your recent grad plan sheet from your sophomore conference. Compare it to your transcript posted in Skyward Portfolio. Full-year course = 1 credit; Semester course = .5 credit.
