

St. Anne-Pacelli is a preschool-12th grade Catholic school located on a 26-acre campus in the heart of Columbus, Georgia. The school provides a faith-based, college preparatory education for students. The high school has been in operation since 1958.

Highlights

- The Class of 2023 had a 100% college acceptance rate and earned over \$2.2 million in college scholarships.
- AP Scholar designations are awarded to students with high scores on multiple AP exams. In 2023, six students achieved AP Scholar with Distinction; seven were designated as AP Scholars with Honors; and 21 were named AP Scholars.
- Members of the Class of 2023 were accepted to 57 different colleges in 22 states. One student is attending the US Air Force Academy and one student is attending the US Military Academy.
- Thirty-seven students participated in study abroad experiences in Panama, Costa Rica and Italy during the 2022-23 school year.

Curriculum

High school students are challenged with a college preparatory curriculum and are required to have a minimum of 24 credits for graduation, including:

- 4 units of English (required each year; must include American Literature & Composition)
- 4 units of Math (required each year; must include Algebra I & II, Geometry & Pre-Calculus)
- 4 units of Science (must include Biology, Chemistry, and Physics)
- 3 units of Social Studies (must include World History, US History & US Government/Economics)
- 2 units of Foreign Language (must be the same language)
- 4 units of Religion (required each year enrolled)
- 1 unit each of Physical Education/Health, Fine Arts, and Electives

Although 24 credits are required for graduation, students are scheduled for seven periods a day. They earn a total of 28 credits, which allows for meaningful electives. Graduation requirements exceed the state of Georgia requirements, the HOPE Scholarship rigor requirements, and the NCAA rigor requirements.

Honors/Pre-AP Courses: 17 honors & 11 Pre-AP courses are offered. 100% of students take Honors/Pre-AP level courses during high school.

AP Courses: 22 AP courses are offered. St. Anne-Pacelli is a College Board-approved AP Capstone school. Students may take AP Seminar and AP Research to pursue the AP Capstone Diploma or AP Seminar & Research Certificate.

Dual Enrollment: 8 courses are offered on-campus in partnership with Columbus State University and Georgia Military College. Students may also enroll in online dual enrollment classes during the school day.

Foreign Languages: Spanish, French, Italian, Japanese and American Sign Language. Students may elect to pursue a Global Competency Diploma Seal by completing specified courses & activities and completing a capstone project.

Fine Arts & Media: Courses are offered in Visual Arts, Ceramics, AP Studio Arts, Drama, Technical Theatre, Piano Lab, Band, TV Production, Film and Graphics, and AP Computer Science.

Electives: Electives include Forensic Science, Robotics, Marine Biology, Current Events, AP Psychology, AP Statistics, Marketing, Anatomy, Weight Training, Astronomy, AP Human Geography, and more.

Service: 100 percent of high school students participate in community service, completing two sevice projects each year culminating in a senior service project.

Advanced courses are weighted for GPA and Honor Rolls. Honors/Pre-AP courses receive an additional 0.5 point. AP and Dual Enrollment courses receive an additional 1.0 point.









Clubs & Activities

Students are encouraged to participate in a variety of clubs and activities to develop their interests and leadership skills. St. Anne-Pacelli offers 10 honor societies, three academic teams, and a variety of special interest clubs. Leadership skills are developed through Student Council, Student Ambassadors, and various nationally-known programs such as Model UN, Ducks Unlimited and Mock Trial. Fine Arts opportunities include Theatre, Percussion Ensemble, Drum Line, Chorus, Art Team, One Act Play, and Literary Team.

Athletics

Over 82% of high school students participate in one or more sports offered by the Viking Athletics program. St. Anne-Pacelli is a AAAA member school of the Georgia Independent Athletic Association and currently offers the following sports: Baseball, Basketball, Dance, Cheerleading, Cross Country, Esports, Flag Football, Football, Golf, Soccer, Swimming, Tennis, Track & Field, Volleyball and Wrestling. Six members of the Class of 2023 committed to play sports at the collegiate level.
